

Personal Insurance

The Northamptonshire Shamblers does not provide any insurance cover for personal injury/accident for those who partake in any activities organised by the Northamptonshire Shamblers.

At the start of each walk, those taking part are asked to sign a register which, confirms that they are fit and able to participate in the walk and accepts the above statement.

Photography

As part of our enjoyment of walking through the countryside, some of us like to take photographs of what we have seen - be it a bird, a butterfly, a flower or just a scene. Of course, you are very welcome to do this bearing in mind we need to get back for lunch. If you'd like to have your photo's on the Shamblers' web site contact the secretary, but there are some issues of which you should be aware. These are summarised below although this is not an exhaustive list. Changes in legislation – particularly in Data Protection matters, may arise.

- When you take a photograph then you hold the copyright.
- Some individuals may not wish to be included in your photograph and their wishes must be respected – especially if it is taken with the intention for inclusion on the web site.
- Any photographs submitted to the secretary for the web site will have their size – in terms of the number of pixels, reduced. Whilst the photo on the web site will be quite acceptable, if it is enlarged it will lose some of its definition and appear very grainy. The reason for this reduction is to minimise the down loading time from the internet.
- If another walker would like a copy of a photograph, they should email the secretary with the reference number and this will be emailed to the originator and the requestor notified accordingly. If the originator is no longer a member, then the requestor will be advised. The Shamblers will in either event have fulfilled their duty and no further action will be taken.
- The maximum number of photos per walk will be limited to six. In the event of more than six photos being received, the secretary will liaise with committee members to make the selection.

Comments

Walkers will be invited to submit their comments on the walk – up to a maximum of 150 words per member, providing that the comments are not abusive of members or guests or their property. The committee's decision will be final.

Up to two comments per walk will be accepted and it is hoped that no one individual will be a regular contributor. In other words, if you are not successful initially, please do not be too disheartened. You may be lucky next time so just keep writing.
